Schools

Our east window was repaired and restored, and we now have a large work party every month which spends time repairing and improving our buildings, at a considerable saving to the Church.

And the great generosity of you all and the hard work of raising money through church, hall, concerts and events means that we have managed to balance our books and are once again in the black.

Finally it is thanks to everyone here at All Saints and the wider Team that I have been given the honorary title of Canon of St Alban's and as Chair of the house of clergy, which gives me a senior role in the Diocese.
