Our volunteers have given approximately 150 person-hours this year plus many hours at the May Plant Sale and more hours trimming the hall hedges in August.

They carried out the usual essential works including:-

- Removal of Yew berry seeds from the gutters; cleaning out of road gullies and blocked rainwater hoppers, especially the tower roof outlets.
- Removing, cleaning and resetting floor wood blocks within the church, a little job we normally keep for wet days.
- ✓ Some re-pointing of stonework, repairs to lead flashing, re-painting the down pipes, repairs to damaged items, treatment of the oak doors. Still more to do!

We have spent a lot of time and effort on St. John's Hall, the annex and external areas around the church particularly weeding and cleaning walls and paths.

We have been fortunate in having from four to ten volunteers turning up each month.
