- 1 Apologies were as for the preceding Vestry Meeting. Owing to constraints imposed because of the Corona Virus Pandemic, a list of attendees was not passed around to be signed. - 4 The Vicar announced that all reports to the meeting were already published on the parish website during the last month and that offers of paper copies had been made.
- 5 The following were elected to serve on the PCC.
