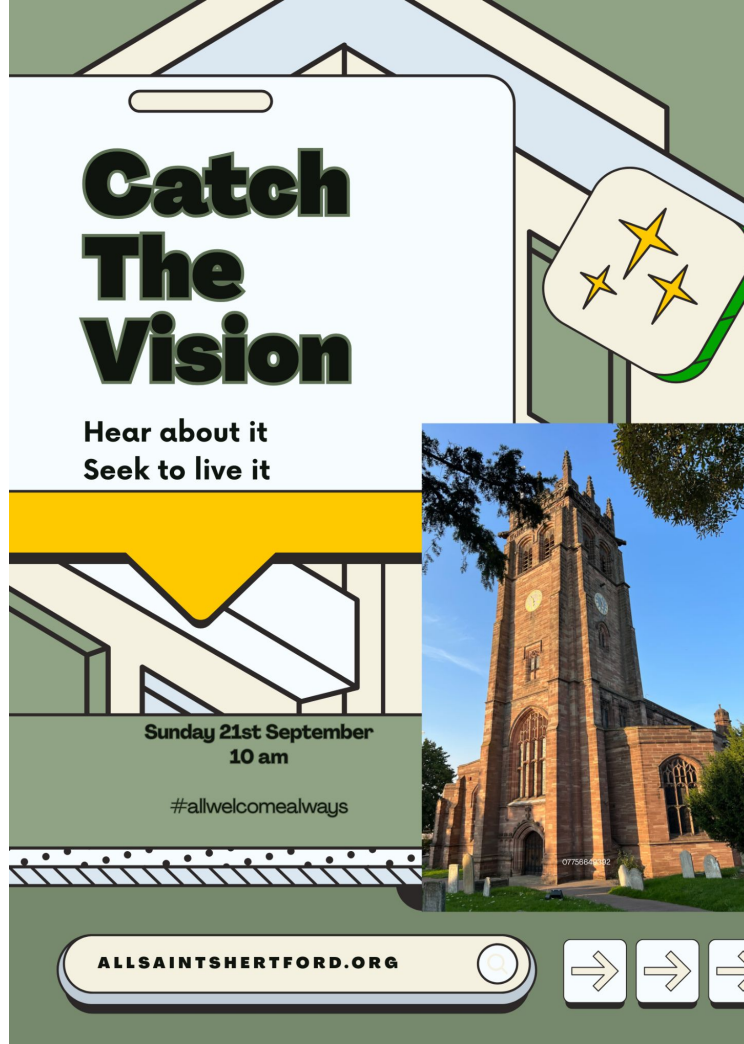

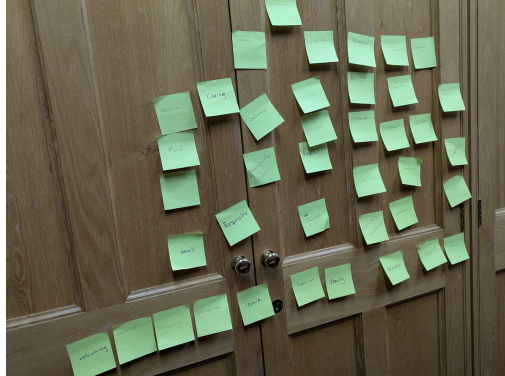
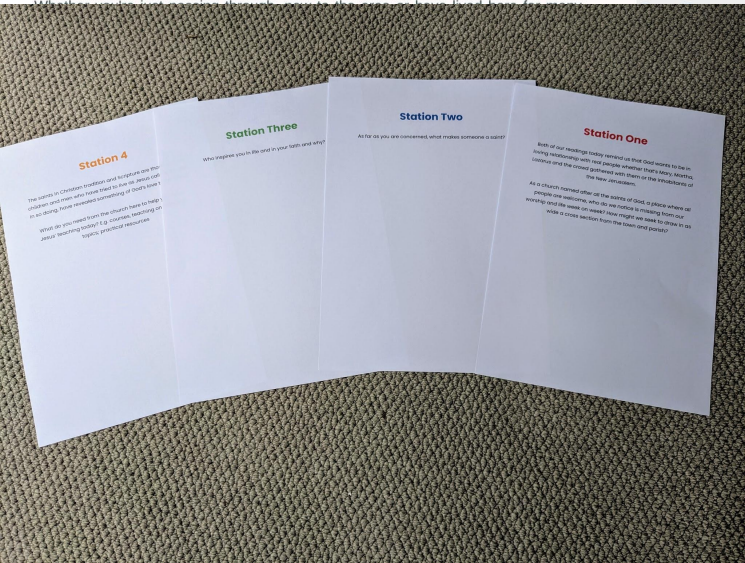

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Igniting Prayer at All Saints.



- We will teach on prayer through running The Prayer course.
- Use a specially written parish prayer before key events or moments of transition
- Use of the Prayer Tree and use of other resources e.g. in the church and yard.
- Monthly prayer group to deepen spiritual connection.
- Offer personal prayer after Sunday worship services.

What will we see?

01 Six strands of mission will be prayed about in public worship.

02 People will naturally pray about who we are and what we do as a church community.

03 Three key values (inclusive, welcoming community hub) will be prayed about during public worship.

04 Members will speak about their prayer life with confidence.



Renewing Faith at All Saints

- Offer courses and teaching about various aspects of faith
- Grow course leaders.
- Lectio Divina sessions based on upcoming lectionary readings.
- Launch The Living Way - a monthly gathering exploring spiritual disciplines.
- Share personal inspirational stories of faith
- Hear stories of faith in action from other Christian communities.

01 A growing confidence in the faith and faithfulness of the current congregations

02 A desire to put faith into action, serving the Hertford community

03 Growth of the congregation through invitation to others and a desire to go deeper into faith.

04 People coming to faith and being prepared for Confirmation.

Sharing and Showing Love at All Saints.



- We will create a pastoral care group of three distinct layers: praying, virtual visiting, and visiting
- We will risk assess; recruit and train for a safe ministry
- We will create robust systems to book a visit through paper forms and a dedicated email address.
- We will use a dedicated WhatsApp group to confidentially update the group and ask for prayer

- 01 A culture of loving support developed that the whole church owns and participates in.
- 02 People fulfilling their vocation to serve others with the love of God in Christ.



Fun and Fundraising at All Saints

- The establishment of a Social/events Committee to enable us to have fun and raise funds together.
- To help build a wide and diverse community of people from within and outside the church community.

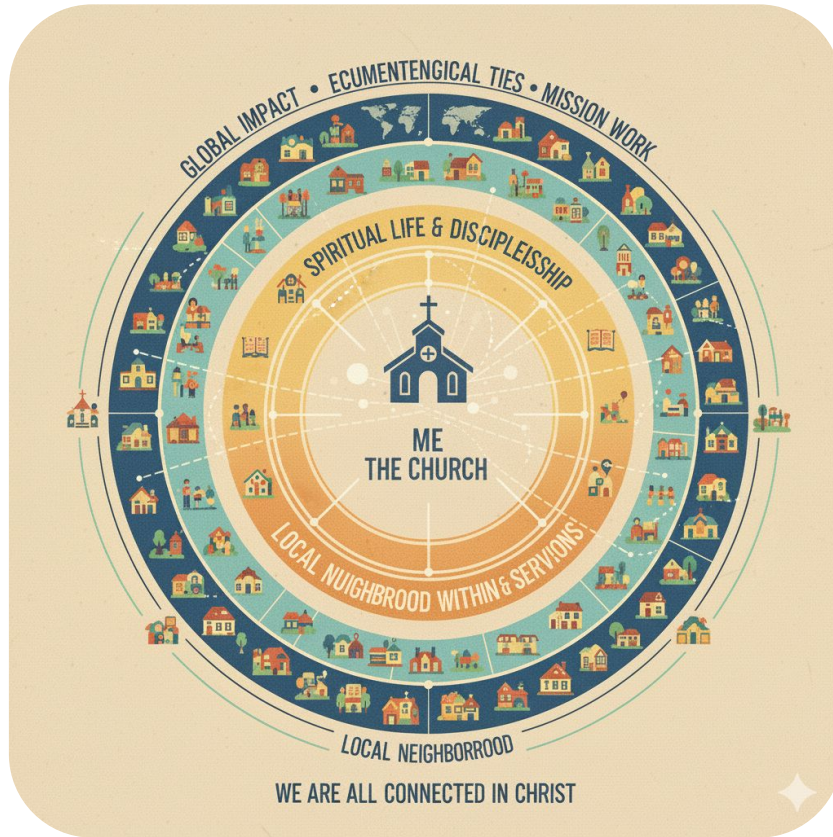
What will we see? Circles of Community

- 02 An ever growing and diverse network of people outside the core of the worshipping community who join us for a growing range of events and activities.

- 03 A wide range of events and activities across the year and an income stream

- Visibility at other town/community events
- Open church building
- Maximise use of church yard.

What will we see? A Building Fit For Our Current Needs.



- 01 Investment and improvement in the building e.g. South aisle roof; heating; lighting; sound
- 02 Begin to dream about creating flexible space within the building
- 03 Increase the number of hires and employ an events manager to oversee.
- 04 The creation of usable meeting and storage space.

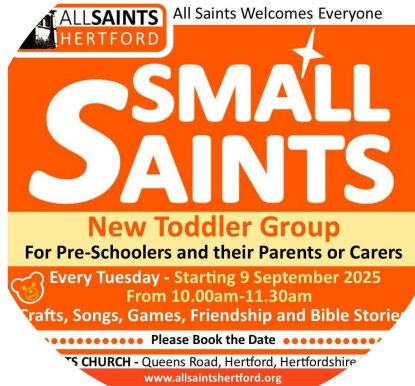
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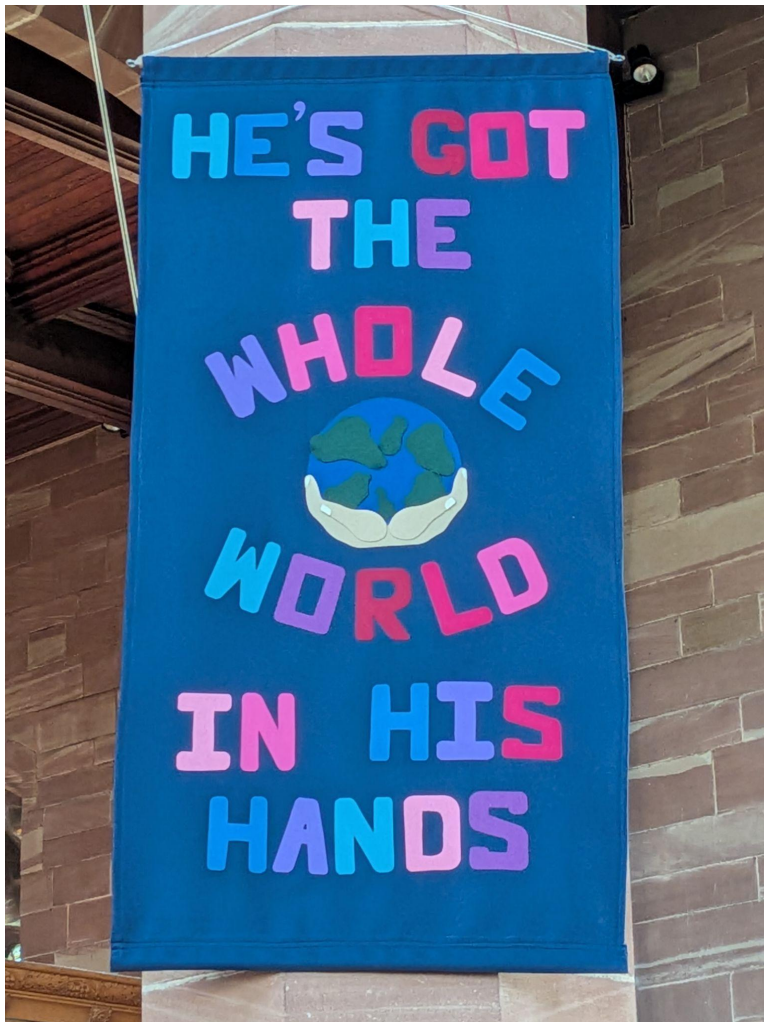

- Produce an action plan to reach Net Zero ASAP.
- Continue and expand our events and activities with an environmental theme.
- Continue to engage with, and expand, where we engage with environmental issues in our worship inc introducing *Wild Church* or *Forest Church*
- Work with other stakeholders towards a sustainable Hertford
